
State law prohibits the use of Consumer and Display Fireworks in Pennsylvania without a permit. Items defined as “ground and hand-held sparkling devices”, “novelties” and “toy caps” in American Pyrotechnics Association (APA) Standard 87-1 are not currently regulated by State Law; therefore, their sale and use are permissible. These “non-fireworks” are the only types allowed to be sold from tents, stands, convenience stores, retail establishments and other various outlets not licensed by the Department of Agriculture.



SPRING BRUSH PICK UP

The Borough of Berwick will pick up brush at curbside on the below dates:

1st WARD Monday, May 2

2nd WARD Tuesday, May 3

3rd WARD Wednesday, May 4

4th WARD Thursday, May 5

- Limbs cannot be larger than 8" in diameter.
- The Borough will only pick up brush on these days.
- Brush must be at curbside no later than 7am on the day of pick-up.
- Residents may also drop off brush and leaves at the Test Track Recycling Compost site on Tuesdays from 1pm - 7pm.
- **Failure to follow the above provisions shall result in no collection at your home.**



CODES CORNER

THIS IS A SMALL SAMPLING OF QUESTIONS THAT COME INTO CITY HALL REGARDING PERMITS, RECYCLING, AND BRUSH PICK UP. IT DOES NOT ANSWER ALL QUESTIONS. IT IS BEST TO CALL CITY HALL AT 570-752-2723 AND ASK QUESTIONS BEFORE YOU START WORK ON YOUR PROPERTY.

- **What WARD am I in?** The Borough of Berwick is broken up into four wards. The 1st ward is from the eastern point of the Borough (Salem Township) to the east side of Market Street. The 2nd Ward is from the west side of Market Street to Oak Street. The 3rd Ward is from west of Oak Street to Warren Street. The 4th Ward is west of Warren Street to the Borough line. See page 6 of this newsletter for dates.
- **I don't have a truck can the Borough crew pick up my brush pile?** The Borough provides a spring and a fall brush pick up. The spring pick up is listed on page 7 of this newsletter. We also place a block ad in the Press Enterprise, put a reminder on the Borough web site www.berwickborough.org and the Berwick.Borough Facebook page.
- **My neighbor sets off illegal fireworks; I am worried that the live ash will start a fire what can I do?** Cherry bombs, M-80s, M-100s, silver salutes and other illegal fireworks are all extremely dangerous. If you know that someone in the Borough is setting off illegal fireworks, please call 911 to report it. They will dispatch an officer.
- **My neighbor parks a tractor trailer on our street and lets it running for a long time, what can I do?** Berwick Noise Ordinance 99-3 Section C.(2) states: No person shall operate or permit the operation of any motor vehicle or any auxiliary equipment attached to such a vehicle, for a period of time longer than fifteen (15) minutes in any hour while the vehicle is stationary, for reasons other than traffic congestion, anywhere within one hundred and fifty (150) feet of any residence in such a manner as to cause a noise disturbance across a residential property line (boundary). Call 911 to report it. They will dispatch an officer.
- **What are the times for the Noise Ordinance?** No noise between the hours of 11PM - 7AM.
- **Do I need a permit to have a small swimming pool for my kids?** Yes, Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code requires that all pools with a depth of two (2) feet or more (or the possibility to be filled to a depth of 2 feet or more), or a pool that has a pump are required to be inspected. Especially keep this in mind when you purchase the small blue INTEX pools or the inflatable pools. You can contact City Hall at 570-752-2723 or go to our web site at www.berwickborough.org and click on ordinances and downloads on the left for a fee listing.
- **Temporary NO PARKING signs are posted on our street today. What are they for?** Please obey posted NO PARKING signs. Berwick has a Parking Enforcement Officer that does patrol the borough. Temporary NO PARKING signs are usually up due to an event or in the summer time most likely mean the street sweeper will be coming through. Tickets will not be rescinded (canceled) by City Hall. If you feel you have received the ticket unfairly you may dispute the ticket through the District Magistrate's office.
- **Why does the Borough have to inspect my apartment?** The Borough inspection of rental properties protects both the tenant and the landlord by alerting them to potential hazardous problems, it is the law in the borough.
- **I see some yards in the Borough do not mow their grass or garbage is over flowing, isn't that a violation of Borough Code?** Both of these issues are a violation of Borough Code. You may report this to our Codes Officers by calling City Hall at 570-752-2723 or go on line at www.berwickborough.org and click on "Report It Yourself" and fill out the on line form. Either way you do not have to leave your name. But we will need the address of the property you are reporting. Please know when you report this it does not mean that your neighbor will act right away to correct the reported problem. Law requires our Codes Officers must follow a set procedure that allows the property owner time to comply. It can be a lengthy process especially if property owner does not work with us to correct issues.
- **Do I need a permit to have an electrical outlet installed in my house?** If you are installing a new outlet by running new wiring than yes, you do. If you are changing out an existing outlet, no you do not. As with any home improvements please check with City Hall before starting any work. Our code Officers will be happy to answer any questions you many have.
- **How do I rent a pavilion at Ber-Vaughn?** Call City Hall at (570) 752-2723 for a Saturday or Sunday reservations, the cost is \$10.00 a pavilion.
