Significant Investigations

On January 26, 2015 the Borough of Berwick Police Department working in conjunction with the Pennsylvania Office of the Attorney General concluded a lengthy investigation regarding the distribution of Heroin from 107 Jessup Street. Officers and agents executed a search warrant at 107 Jessup Street, the Bryan Smith residence. As a result of the warrant service, 621 packets of Heroin, electronic scales and packaging paraphernalia were seized as evidence.

Later that day, Sincere Johnson and Shannon Schrader arrived at 107 Jessup and were secured into police custody. Johnson was in possession of \$3,841 in US currency and 41 packets of Heroin. In the vehicle with Johnson was Shannon Schrader. Schrader was in possession of \$1,045 and 31 packets of Heroin.

Overall, police seized \$4886 in US currency and 693 packets of Heroin.

Smith, Johnson and Schrader were each charged with drug related crimes.
