§ 99-1. Use restrictions.

No person shall, except in the necessary defense of person or property, fire or discharge any gun or other firearm or shoot with any bow and arrow at any place within the Borough of Berwick, provided that nothing herein shall prohibit the use of firearms at any rifle or bow and arrow range, the location of which shall have been approved by the Mayor, supervised by an adult whose qualifications have been approved by the Mayor.

§ 99-2. Violations and penalties.¹

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof before any District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$300 and costs of prosecution and in default of payment thereof to imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 30 days.
