## BOROUGH OF BERWICK PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES DECEMBER 18, 2017

AGENDA: Public Hearing Owner-Occupied Housing Rehabilitation Application was held Monday, December 18, 2017 at 6:30PM in City Hall.

PUBLIC Sue Goddard from SEDA-COG addressed those HEARING: attendance. She explained that the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) provides the funding through the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) through a competitive application process.

> The Borough of Berwick has received six HOME grants to date, resulting in rehabilitation of 74 homes at a direct cost of \$2,010,256.03. The current grant (phase VI) is complete and ready to close out. There are twenty-six homeowners on the wait list currently as well as an additional nine who have re-applied after previously receiving rehabilitation services.

> Among the program requirements are home ownership, meeting the income guidelines, and having taxes and municipal utility bills paid and current. No homeowners are displaced as a part of the program. Environmental factors are reviewed, both Borough-wide and for the specific project site.

> Written comments will be accepted until December 29, 2017. A formal resolution will be voted upon at the January 15, 2018 Council meeting, and the grant application deadline is February 5, 2018.
